



Heating, Ventilating and Air Conditioning Program (*HVAC5*)

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

The Heating, Ventilating, and Air Conditioning (HVAC) program is designed to provide graduates with the necessary skills and knowledge needed for careers as HVAC Technicians or Installers. The National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER) develops standardized curricula and assessments with portable credentials which are tracked through NCCER's National Registry. The increasing development of HVAC technology causes employers to recognize the importance of continuous education and keeping up to speed with the latest equipment and skills. Students who pass the qualifications will earn industry recognized NCCER Certification. There are four levels in the HVAC program which are North American Technician Excellence (NATE) recognized and present theoretical and practical skills essential to your success as an HVAC Installer or Technician. The program is 678 clock hours in length.
